

CABINET OF THE VIRGIN ISLANDS - POST MEETING STATEMENT

CABINET DECISIONS 30th May, 2019

His Excellency the Acting Governor Mr. David Archer, Jr. chaired the Meeting held on 30th May, 2019 in the absence of Governor Augustus Jaspert, who was overseas on official business. The meeting was held at the Premier's Conference Room, Central Administration Building.

All Members were present at the Meeting.

Cabinet Meeting – 30th May, 2019

The Cabinet:

- 1. Reviewed the amendments to the Computer Misuse and Cybercrime (Amendment) Act, 2019 and decided that the Premier's Office instruct the Attorney General's Chambers to amalgamate the additional amendments into one comprehensive document for Cabinet's further approval.
- Approved the sum of fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000.00) per annum, effective 1st January, 2019, as the new rent payable for leased land in Long Look for the sole purpose to lay, construct and/or maintain pipelines.
- 3. Decided that the tender process be waived for the procurement of durable letter boxes to replace those destroyed by the hurricanes of 2017 due to the commercial and social importance of such a service and that following enquiries, it has been determined that U.S. Mail Supply Inc., which was selected over and above the two other companies, be awarded a contract for the sum not to exceed four hundred and eighty two thousand, six hundred and seventy six dollars (\$482,676) on the basis of durability, the manufacturing time factor and the urgency of restoring the BVI's postal services, in line with international standards, with a view to generating the much needed revenue for the Territory and decided that the project will be executed in the following phases:
 - (a) 2019 Phase I at a cost of \$257,999;
 - (b) 2020 Phase II at a cost of \$174,312; and
 - (c) 2021 Phase III at a cost of \$50,365.

4. Approved a number of Non-Belongers Land Holding Licences.

Further information on these matters will be provided by the Premier and Ministers in due course.
