Question 1

Madam Speaker, would the Premier and Minister of Finance please inform this Honourable House, to date, notwithstanding that provided at the Seventh Sitting of the Second Session of the Third House of Assembly, of the total amount expended from the \$25,000,000 loan facility from First Caribbean International Bank that was approved by the House of Assembly and please state the current balance to be drawn down?

Question 2

Madam Speaker, would the Premier and Minister of Finance please inform this Honourable House when the outstanding audited Financial Statements for the years 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2016 would be completed and made public?

i) If they are not completed please state when would they be completed?

Question 3

Madam Speaker, would the Premier and Minister of Finance please give this Honourable House a full update on the ongoing discussions with Delta Petroleum and the Government of the Virgin Islands in reference to the Privy Council's ruling on the case that the Government of the Virgin Islands lost to Delta Petroleum?

Question 4

Madam Speaker, would the Premier and Minister of Finance please inform this Honourable House why were the funds disbursed to BVI Airways/BV Airways by the Government of the Virgin Islands earlier than the dates set forth in the schedule of the signed agreement between both parties?

- i) State if the Government of the Virgin Islands has received from BVI Airways/BV Airways an account of how the money received by the airline from Government was spent?
- ii) If not, has government requested such information and has it been received?
- iii) If not, will government be requesting such information?

Madam Speaker, in a statement made by the Premier and Minister of Finance a few weeks ago, it was stated that the planes are owned by an outfit known as Raptor and leased to BVI Airways, could the Premier and Minister of Finance please inform this Honourable House who is Raptor and if government's money was used to purchase the planes why do they appear to belong to another company which is not part of the agreement?

- i) If the planes are owned by Raptor and were purchased with government money in the name of BVI Airways, why is the airline now paying to lease planes that were already paid for?
- ii) If the planes were purchased with government money in the name of BVI Airways and then transferred to Raptor, how much money did Raptor pay BVI Airways?
- iii) Did BVI Airways sell the planes to Raptor at a profit or a loss and has that money been accounted for?
- iv) Is the lease between Raptor and BVI Airways commercially reasonable based upon aircraft value and industry standards?
- v) How long is the lease term and what penalties will the Government of the Virgin Islands incur if the lease is not paid?
- vi) Who are the beneficial owners of Raptor?

Question 6

Madam Speaker, the agreement between BVI Airways/BV Airways and the Government of the Virgin Islands calls for repayment to the Government of Virgin Islands the \$7,000,000.00 by BVI Airways/BV Airways; if lease payments are being made to Raptor for the aircraft(s) that were paid for using government money and the government is not a beneficial owner of Raptor, how does the Government of the Virgin Islands get repaid?

Question 7

Madam Speaker, would the Premier and Minister of Finance please inform this Honourable House if BVI Airways is in full compliance with the contract signed between BVI Airways/BV Airways and the Government of the Virgin Islands?

i) If not, what specific areas are they not in compliance with and what actions are being taken by the Government of the Virgin Islands to ensure compliance?

Madam Speaker, would the Premier and Minister of Finance please inform this Honourable House if BVI Airways/BV Airways has advised the Government of the Virgin Islands of a start-up date for service to and from Miami now that it has been reported that the airline has completed certification in America?

- i) Inform where the public can go to book flights and purchase tickets on BVI Airways/BV Airways to and from Miami to the Virgin Islands?
- ii) If the above is not accessible now, please state when the service will be accessible to the public?
- iii) Are there provisions in the agreement and addendum agreement for termination by the Government of the Virgin Islands of BVI Airways/BV Airways for non-performance by BVI Airways/BV Airways?

Madam Speaker, could the Minister for Communications and Works please inform this Honourable House whether or not he received engineering reports regarding the structural integrity of the Jetty given the reported degradation of the steel works at the under-side of the dock?

Question 4

Madam Speaker, from the inception of the Cruise Pier Project to date, would the Minister for Communications and Works please state for this Honourable House the name(s) of each law firm(s), legal person(s), legal consultants and/or legal companies hired on the Cruise Pier Development project?

- i) State the amount paid to each of them along with the description of works?
- ii) State each subcontractor(s) that was approved to work along with each legal firm(s)/person(s) on the project?
- iii) Provide a copy of each contract or terms of engagement?
- iv) State if any variation was paid to any of the legal entities, and if yes, state the legal person and/or firm and the amount paid in variation to each?
- v) List all outstanding monies owed to any legal firm/person on the project and the description of what the outstanding funds are to be paid for?
- vi) Inform if the tendering process was used to hire each legal entity? and, if not, why not?
- vii) In the cases where the tender process was not used, inform the procedure used to hire each of the legal entities used on the project?

Madam Speaker, during the Seventh Sitting of the Second Session of the Third House of Assembly the Minister for Communications and Works informed this Honourable House that the total cost of the Cruise Pier Project was \$82,815,759.73 with the total of the Marine phase being \$37,532,165.27 and the total of the Land phase being \$37,709,550.58. Seeing that the combined total of the land and marine phase does not total \$82,815,759.73, could the Minister please inform the Honourable House of the names of each vendor/contractor paid from the \$7,574,043.88 which is the total from the difference of the combined total of the marine and land phase from the total of the cost of the project?

- v) State which vendor/contractor variations payments were made to, the amounts and the description of the work that required the variation payment?
