CABINET DECISIONS
8th January, 2020

His Excellency the Governor Augustus Jaspert chaired the Meeting held on 8th January, 2020 at Abe's by the Sea, Little Harbour, Jost Van Dyke.

All Members were present.

Cabinet Meeting – 8th January, 2020

The Cabinet:

1. Reviewed and accepted the Annual Reports of the Deputy Governor's Office for the years ending 2016 and 2017 and decided that they be laid on the table in the House of Assembly at the next convenient Sitting.
2. Decided that the Road Traffic (Taxi and Livery Commission) Regulations, 1997 (as amended) Regulation 15B(5), 15C, 15D, and 15E be repealed in order to remove the Appeals Tribunal process and related matters from the Regulations, but that the administrative hearings provided for under Regulation 15A be retained, and decided that the Regulations be amended to make provisions for the Public Transport Operator to pay administrative penalties to the Magistrate's Court.
3. Revoked the decisions to grant land to a number of persons in the Spooners Estate subdivision for failure to meet the required obligations and placed those persons on a deferred list for consideration at a later date when land becomes available.
4. Approved one Non-Belongers land holding licence application and one application for the lease of Crown land for commercial use.
