CABINET DECISIONS **19th June, 2019**

His Excellency the Governor Augustus Jaspert chaired the Meeting held on 19th June, 2019, which was held at the Premier's Conference Room, Central Administration Building.

All Members were present at the Meeting.

Cabinet Meeting – 19th June, 2019

The Cabinet:

1. Decided that the Bill entitled, Beneficial Ownership Secure Search System (Amendment) (No. 2) Act, 2019 be introduced in the House of Assembly, which seeks to amend the Beneficial Ownership Secure Search System Act, 2017 ("BOSS Act").
2. Decided that Romasco Holdings Limited be granted permission to dredge no more than two thousand (2,000) cubic yards (yds³) of sand only in the seabed at Great Harbour, Peter Island for use in restoring the beach area, subject to a number of conditions.
3. Approved the Bill entitled, Virgin Islands Trade in Endangered Species (CITES) Act, which provides for the implementation of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES) and decided that the Bill be introduced for its first reading in the House of Assembly at the next convenient Sitting.
4. Approved the appointments of the following persons as members of the BVI Health Services Authority Board for a period of two (2) years with effect from 19th June, 2019: Dr. Yvonne Renee Venzen, Mr. Lemuel Smith, Ms. Kisha Frett, Ms. Esther Wheatley, Mrs. Kishelle Blaize-Cameron and Ms. Andrea Walters.
5. Approved one Non-Belonger land holding licence.
