

THE CABINET OF THE VIRGIN ISLANDS - POST MEETING STATEMENT

CABINET DECISIONS

27th April, 2022

Cabinet Meeting – 27th April, 2022

His Excellency, the Governor John J. Rankin, CMG, chaired the Meeting held at the Financial Services Commission's Resource Centre on 27th April, 2022.

All Members were present, with the exception of the Premier and Minister of Finance, Minister for Transportation, Works and Utilities, and the Minister for Natural Resources, Labour and Immigration, who were overseas on official travel.

The Acting Minister for Natural Resources, Labour and Immigration Hon. Alvera Maduro-Caines attended the meeting.

The Cabinet:

1. Accepted the proposals for Expression of Interest from two companies for consultancy services for re-development plan for Civil Aviation Regulatory Services for the British Virgin Islands and decided that the Ministry of Transportation, Works and Utilities provide full terms of reference and thereafter invite the companies to submit technical and financial proposals to undertake the assignment.
2. Reviewed and accepted the Evaluation Report submitted by the Central Tenders Board's (CTB) technical committee, which the CTB approved on 23rd March, 2022; accepted the CTB's recommendation to award Top Priority Security Services Limited the contract to Supply Security Services for Transportation of Government Funds on Tortola, Virgin Gorda, Jost Van Dyke and Anegada in the amount of six hundred and ninety-three thousand, three hundred and ninety-two dollars (\$693,392.00) for a period of two (2) years; and decided that the Ministry of Finance instruct the Attorney General's Chambers to vet the draft contract prior to execution.

3. Reviewed and accepted the Evaluation Report submitted by the Central Tenders Board's (CTB) technical evaluation committee, which the CTB approved on 29th March, 2022; accepted the CTB's recommendation to award Building Construction Management Group Ltd. a contract for the construction of the new elevator shaft, procurement, installation and commissioning of a new elevator for the West Atrium of the Ralph T. O'Neal Administration Complex in the amount of one million, seventy-six thousand, seven hundred and ninety-six dollars and ninety-nine cents (\$1,076,796.99); and decided that the Ministry of Transportation, Works and Utilities instruct the Attorney General's Chambers to vet the relevant agreement.
4. Approved two Non-Belonger Land Holding Licence applications.
