- Expected Outcome:** The expected outcome of this Contract is to create a better teaching and learning environment at the temporary Elmore Stoutt High School.
- Summary of Scope:** This scope of work is for improvements to the temporary Elmore Stoutt High School (former Clarence Thomas Limited Building). It includes repairs and eventual upgrades of the existing air-conditioning system, installation of additional lights and power outlets, supply and installation of new doors, storage cabinets and acoustic ceilings, making the staircase safer, refurbishing the teachers' lounge and supply and installation of emergency lights and signage.
- Method of Procurement:** National Competitive Bidding (NCB)
