The Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions on 18th March, 2022 has filed an appeal against the decision of Learned Trial Judge Justice R. C. Williams to uphold the submission that Pamphill Prevost and Simon Power had no case to answer for the sole count of conspiracy to steal. This decision was made on 14th March, 2022.

The Crown has the right to appeal such a decision under the Criminal Procedure Ordinance Cap 18 (as amended). The Crown appeals the decision of the Learned Trial Judge on the ground that the decision was fundamentally incorrect in law, amongst other grounds of Appeal.

The Crown's case was led by Learned Queen's Counsel, Mr John Black, QC and Mr Prevost and Mr Power were represented by Learned Counsel Mr Terrence Williams and Mr Israel Bruce, respectively.
