

What is the National Addressing System?

The National Addressing System or NAS, for short, is a framework designed to establish a reliable and consistent method of assigning a geographic and numeric address to all buildings within an area. This address will comprise of a street name, unique number, and postal code to each building and property along all roads in the towns and the wider Territory.



What is the purpose of the NAS?

The assignment of addresses facilitates reliable and fast identification of buildings throughout the Territory.

What are the major benefits of the NAS?

NAS will be of great benefit to individual families, communities, businesses and government agencies alike and be the catalyst to facilitate the timely and efficient delivery of services including:



Emergency responders: Enabling precise locations to be identified during emergency situations for Fire, Police, Ambulance and others.



Post Office and mail couriers: Enabling door to door home and business deliveries.



Billing/collection services for public and private sectors
W&S, BVIEC, Cable TV, etc.

How will those emergency responders, mail couriers and others be able to locate me?

So far, all addresses for the Road Town Registration Section have been mapped into the Geographic Information System (GIS), which means that once an address is entered into the system, responders will have the ability to see the route and navigate directly to the address. While the Road Town Registration Section is being used as a pilot area, systematic expansion to the entire Territory is scheduled for the near future.

What will my full physical address look like?
