

Operation Restoration- Long Bay, Beef Island Seagrape Tree Name Nomination Form

The first 100 seagrape trees planted under Operation Restoration will be named after deceased Virgin Islanders from the Seventh and Eighth Districts who have made significant contributions to the community fabric or community development, especially in the areas of environmental protection/stewardship, history and culture, education, farming, fishing, boat building or other historic aspects of socio-economic development. Naming the trees seeks to build a sense of community connection to and stewardship for the trees and to preserve the legacy of these significant community builders.

The public is invited to nominate persons meeting these criteria for trees to be named after during Environment Month 2024.
