

# BVI's Policy on WEARING MASKS

Effective June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022

The wearing of face masks or face coverings, whether indoors or outdoors, is **no longer mandated by law**, but will be allowed as a **matter of choice in public spaces**.

Private establishments or service providers may institute its own policy on mask wearing. The Deputy Governor has developed a policy on the areas where mask wearing is still required, such as in agencies providing health and social care, border protection services, and other front-facing departments where the risk of exposure is higher.
